

Factsheet Delivery Parking

Driving in traffic areas / Parking / Long-term parking

Owing to the KONGRESSHALLE's central location directly on a public thoroughfare, driving, parking and/or long-term parking in the KONGRESSHALLE traffic areas is subject to the following rules:

Driving in traffic areas

The traffic areas directly in front of the KONGRESSHALLE are managed by different operators (and are also weight-restricted):

- Footpath (urban council): max. 3.5 t/m².
- Other (KONGRESSHALLE): max. 0.5 t/m².



As a rule, the delivery area/loading zone must be used. For structural engineering reasons, driving on or stopping on the footpath (urban council) directly in front of the KONGRESSHALLE for the purpose of loading or unloading exhibition items is not permitted.

All other traffic areas of the KONGRESSHALLE serve building and event security (fire protection / fire brigade assembly area, medical services / emergency physician, security / evacuation, catering, cleaning, other operational services) and must be kept free. Vehicles that do not serve these purposes are not permitted to park here.

As the operator of the KONGRESSHALLE, Leipziger Messe GmbH reserves the right to enforce its house rules and to have vehicles towed away that are parked there without authorisation.

Where capacity is available, other traffic areas may be marketed for advertising purposes in connection with specific events. Any such arrangements will be agreed between the tenant and the landlord.

Parking / Long-term parking

Parking / long-term parking in the traffic areas of the KONGRESSHALLE for reasons other than those specified above is not permitted.

It is recommended that cars be parked at the Parkhaus Zoo multi-storey car park directly opposite the KONGRESSHALLE.
